

Costa Group Holdings Limited to be removed from the S&P/ASX 200 Index

SYDNEY, FEBRUARY 1, 2024: S&P Dow Jones Indices announced today that it will remove Costa Group Holdings Limited (XASX: CGC) from the S&P/ASX 200 Index, subject to FIRB and final court approval of the scheme of arrangement whereby the company will be acquired by Paine Schwartz Partners, LLC, Driscoll's, Inc and British Columbia Investment Management Corporation.

S&P Dow Jones Indices will remove Costa Group Holdings Limited from the S&P/ASX 200 effective prior to the open of trading on **Friday, February 9, 2024**. Costa Group Holdings Limited will be replaced by Strike Energy Limited (ASX: STX) in the S&P/ASX 200 effective prior to the open of trading on **Friday, February 9, 2024**.
