

Gold Road Resources Limited to be removed from the S&P/ASX 200 Index

SYDNEY, SEPTEMBER 22, 2025: S&P Dow Jones Indices announced today that it will remove Gold Road Resources Limited (XASX: GOR) from the S&P/ASX 200 Index, subject to scheme meeting and final court approval whereby the company will be acquired by Gold Fields Limited (XJSE: GFI).

S&P Dow Jones Indices will remove Gold Road Resources Limited from the S&P/ASX 200 effective prior to the open of trading on Monday, September 29, 2025. Gold Road Resources Limited will be replaced by Catapult Sports Limited (XASX: CAT), in the S&P/ASX 200 effective prior to the open of trading on Monday, September 29, 2025.
